Gathering together

How good it is to be in worship together again! That was April's "good news of great joy" (it felt like Christmas at Easter to me!). Thank you for your patience and persistence as we continue to practice our health-and-safety protocols under the watchful guidance of the Reopening Steering Committee.

In the meantime, behind the scenes, in March and April, your elected leaders (Deacons, Trustees, Church Council) and the Steering Committee for the pastor search process have invested hours with one another in listening sessions that have identified "Best Things" about First Baptist High Point, "Assets for the Future," "Liabilities for the Future," and "Questions We Need to Answer." Participation has been excellent, as 86% of the leadership has attended, and every attendee has contributed to the conversation. This work of the Leadership Team is setting the stage for congregation-wide sessions that will consider (and add to) the outcomes of the Leadership Team sessions. I want to share a "sneak peek" at some of the top-tier findings from these conversations. Your turn is coming soon, so as you read through these, think about:

- how you would answer the three "leading questions" below;
- what questions you think we most need answers to about our best things, assets, and liabilities: and
- •how you would answer the questions the Leadership Team said we most need answered.

Leading Question 1: "If you were speaking to someone who knew nothing about First Baptist High Point, what would you say is the best thing about your church?" The top "best things" (out of 47) identified by the members of the Leadership Team are "the worship service," "the Christ-centeredness" of the church, and "the friendliness of members." (Others included the "great choir" and "excellent Sunday School"). When asked to identify the most important questions we need to answer about these "best things," the top two on the minds of the Leadership Team were "Is our worship style and music type engaging and relevant to people outside our congregation?" and "What are the components that make our worship service our best feature?"

Leading Question 2: "What are the greatest assets or strengths for the future of First Baptist High Point?" the Leadership Team identified 26 assets and rated "our Christ-centeredness," "our people," and "our facilities/physical campus" the most highly. (Others included "sharing the campus with other organizations," "strong Sunday

School," and "debt being free.) The top two questions on the minds of the Leadership Team about our assets "Given were our level of yearly financial resources, how do we best use them to be the church?" and



"How do we effectively utilize our facilities to meet needs of the congregation and the community?"

Leading Questions 3: "What are the greatest liabilities or weaknesses of First Baptist High Point for the future?" members of the Leadership Team were especially concerned about finances and the lack of giving units, the number of members, the aging of the congregation, and the cost of repairs to aging facilities among the 27 they identified. (Others were "need a preacher," "lack of next generation – adults under 40," and "lack of children/youth".) Their most important questions of these liabilities were "How do we increase our giving units?" and "What are the most important features we are looking for in a preacher?"

That last question, "What are the most important features we are looking for in a preacher?" is the reason we are engaged in this process! With the results of these and other conversations yet to come in view, the Pastor Search Committee will develop a "Pastoral Profile" that identifies the most important features in a Senior Minister for First Baptist High Point based on a clear understanding of who we are – and who we understand ourselves called by God to become – and where we are – and where we understand ourselves called by God to go.

Please continue to "pray without ceasing" (1 Thessalonians 5:17) for the Leadership Team, the congregation at large, the Search Committee who will be elected at the conclusion of this process, and the Senior Minister to whom God will lead us.

The first quarter is in the books. Year-to-date giving was \$64,384. Budget is for \$97,236. Our giving is averaging \$4,952/ week when we add in the online and credit card gifts.

Spending for the three months was \$63,154, so we're \$1,230 to the good. There's nothing really unusual to report. Our actual expenses are running at \$20k to \$22k per month as anticipated, so we're just covering current costs.

Financial Report

Extra next month: the billing for the gym heater repairs has not been booked yet – that will be \$5,983 to be paid in April. Based on break-even giving, we opted to only do the minimum repairs instead of a full replacement that would have cost \$28,000 – it turns out that was a good decision. We have a large physical plant to keep up and we never know when the next big expense will hit us.

It is worth reminding about the \$10,000

Matching Challenge. During a time when we're just barely breaking even, our mission at 405 N. Main St. could benefit greatly by meeting this challenge. In three months, it has brought in a total of \$1,050. If you are able to participate above your normal giving, please note "Challenge" in the memo line on your check.
